

CLIPPER CUP 'ROUND LARUE

Sponsored by The Beaver Lake Sailing Club

Rules

Start & Finish: An imaginary line between the southern-most tip of Dock #5 and the nearby No Wake buoy at the Beaver Lake Sailing Club.

Rounding Mark: Pass within 100 yards (the length of a football field) of the middle one of 3 warning buoys at the Highway 12 Bridge.



Trophies: Every crew member of each boat which completes the course in less than 5 hours and 20 minutes (5:20) will receive a medal to that effect.

SAILBOAT RECORD PASSAGE

Rules

No "cut-off": Every participant must round the extreme tip of the LaRue Peninsula both outbound and inbound. The apparent cut-off is either too shallow or non-existent. The course length is approximately 32 miles.

Eligibility: Any sailboat under sail only. Owners must be members of the BLSC.

Time Period: Any sailboat may attempt a Record Passage at any time, and any number of times, during the period January 15, 2016, through November 30, 2016.

Reporting: The following information must be submitted by the boat's skipper to, and signed by, any officer of the Beaver Lake Sailing Club before midnight, November 30, 2016, and include

- The boat's name, her skipper's name and the names of her crew.
- Her start time, her finish time, and her elapsed time.

Trophies: The boat's name and skipper's name who have the quickest Record Passage for 2016 will be recorded on the Clipper Cup 'Round LaRue Perpetual Trophy and kept on permanent display at Charlton House.
